I. Background and Context:

Vasudha Foundation USA INC was set up in 2014 with the sole purpose of bringing in Southern Voice to Global Policy Making and with the specific intent of engaging actively with the Multilateral Development Institutions with a very specific focus on the World Bank Group (World Bank and IFC) in framing policies that would help in diversifying the portfolios of the World Bank Group to facilitate Developing Economies to address Climate Change and usher in Energy Transition in their respective economies.

Vasudha Foundation USA INC was instrumental in working with a number of NGOs and Think Tanks from the developing economies to engage with NGOs and Think Tanks based in the US and Europe who were already engaging with the World Bank Group in bringing in policies that would help in strengthening Environment and Social Safeguard processes and also in widening the lending and support portfolio of the World Bank group in supporting developing economies to scale up renewable energy and address energy access through sustainable, affordable, clean solutions and specifically focusing on countries / Regions such as India and South Asia and Africa.

Post 2018-19, Vasudha Foundation USA INC also expanded its work in engaging with other multilateral financial institutions such as African Development Bank, the New Development Bank and the

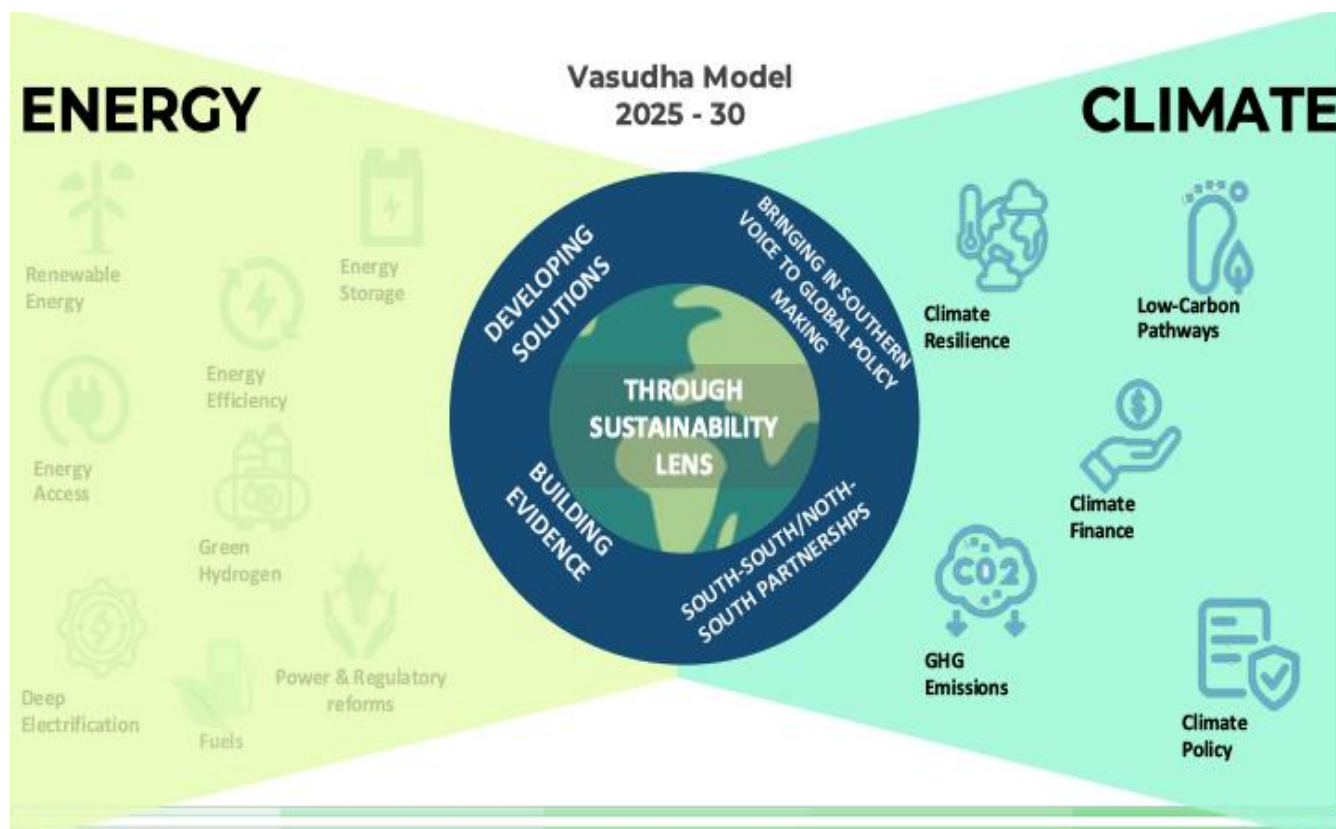
Asia Infrastructure Investment Bank in addition to continued engagement with the World Bank Group.

From 2020 onwards, Vasudha Foundation USA INC also diversified its portfolio to engage in wider energy transition and in line with the developing countries Net Zero Goals, and to also play a leading role in bringing in a southern voice to a broader global policy going beyond multi-lateral development banks, which was its mandate till 2020.

Since 2020 till 2024, Vasudha Foundation USA INC is now engaging in broader climate and energy transition with a view to facilitate developing economies to embark on a data driven net zero and energy transition while also working with countries in Africa and in continued engagement with the Multi-Lateral Financial Institutions, address the issue of energy access and in line with Sustainable Energy for All by 2030.

In the backdrop of the above, the Strategic Plan for the period of 2025-2030 aims to further strengthen the position of Vasudha Foundation as an Organisation that works to facilitate energy transition in developing economies and also facilitating South-South Cooperation and sharing of knowledge and expertise, while also aiming to foster North South Collaboration to scale up the pace of Energy Transition.

II. The Broad Contours of the Strategic Plan 2025-2030



As can be seen from the Strategic Model above, the Strategic Priorities for Vasudha Foundation USA INC for the period of 2025-2030 are:

- A) Aim to become one of the leading organisations that bring in a southern perspective to global policy making on climate, clean energy and energy transition
- B) Aim to become a leading organisation to facilitate South-South and North-South Cooperation on clean energy and climate.
- C) Become a “Go-To” organisation to facilitate energy transition in developing economies with a focus on India (this time period) through multiple strategies and data driven approaches.
- D) Become a “Go-To” organisation for developing solutions for scale up energy transition.

E) Facilitate in building evidences for transformation.
